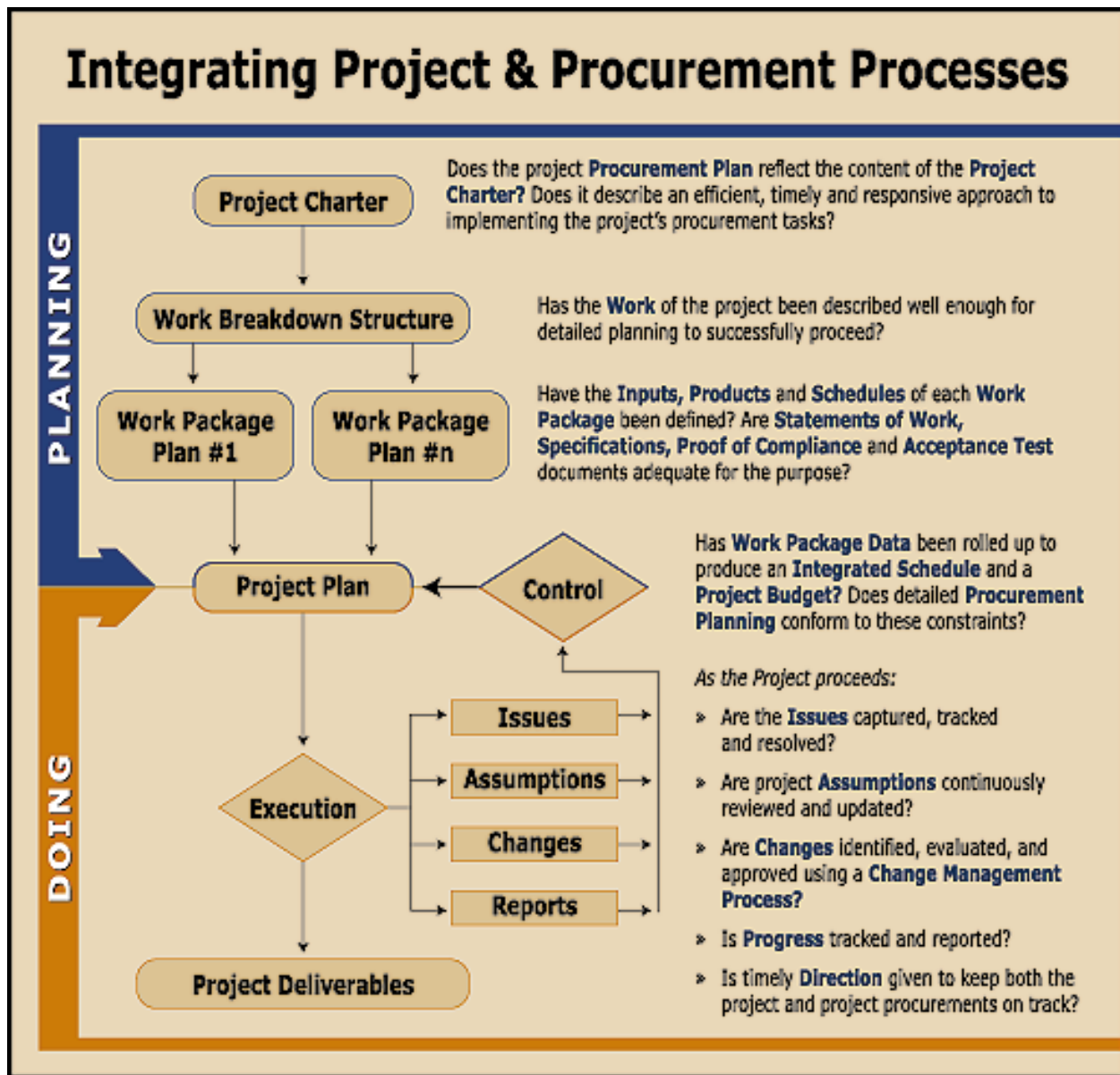


# MANAGING PROJECTS: THE STEP-BY-STEP APPROACH
